RESOLUTION NO. 2023-220
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF YACHATS, OREGON
DECLARING A WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, As the result of a drought and the threat of a continued drought or other condition, the ordinary demands and requirements of water consumers may not be satisfied without depleting the water supply of the City of Yachats to the extent that there may be insufficient water for human consumption, sanitation, or fire protection; and

WHEREAS, The City Council, to protect the health, safety and general welfare of its citizens in the public interest, finds it necessary to adopt regulations necessary to mitigate any water shortage emergency as per the Yachats Municipal Code, Section 8.22; and

NOW THEREFORE, As per section 8.22.030, the City Council accepts the decision of the City Manager/Public Works Director and Declares a Water Shortage Emergency, Phase 1. Should the drought continue, additional restrictions may be imposed, based on the measured flows of the water sources, as per the Yachats Municipal Code, Section 8.22.

This Resolution was adopted by the City Council on September 13, 2023 and is effective as of that date.
